Coronavirus Update for Parish of the Good Shepherd: We have received updated guidance (12th March) from Bishop Richard which is displayed in both our churches. Below is a summary of the guidance for your information and action:-

- Communion under one kind, in the hand.
- No physical sign of peace.
- No Holy Water in the stoups.
- Please do not touch or kiss the statues.
- Vulnerable people with significant underlying medical conditions are advised not to attend parish gatherings or liturgies.
- Hymn books will not be distributed.
- Wash hands and/or use hand sanitizers - we are unable to purchase any, so please, if you have any carry it with you.
- Catch it, kill it & bin it!
- Anyone with cold and flu symptoms should stay at home.
- There will be no collection plate passed around; please place your offertory in the baskets placed at the back of St Thomas' and at the entrances/exits at Holy Redeemer.
- Catering and Refreshments will not be served at or after parish events or liturgies.
- Newsletters will be available to pick up on your way out of both churches.

Thank you for your understanding and continued co-operation. Below is the prayer Pope Francis recited asking Mary to protect Italy and the world during of the coronavirus pandemic. I ask you all to join this act of prayer;

O Mary,
 you always shine on our path
